DATA CONTROLLER AND CONTACTS

PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS

The purpose of the processing is the performance of the transport contract with the clients (including the management of the black list of the cancelled cards) and the revenue allocation among the companies that carry out the service.

The legal basis is the execution of a contract of which the interested party is a party pursuant to art. 6, paragraph 1, letter b, of EU Regulation No. 679/2016.

CATEGORIES OF DATA PROCESSED AND RECIPIENTS

Data processed are ordinary and specific personal data. Personal data are processed by personnel authorized by the data controller and may be communicated to law enforcement, judicial authority and companies that provide goods and/or services related to the processing.

METHODS OF PROCESSING AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF DATA

The data are processed only for the purposes mentioned above and according to the principles of lawfulness, correctness, transparency, accuracy, integrity and confidentiality established by the regulations in force. The personal data management may also take place through automated and computerized processes. No personal data collected will be transferred outside the European Economic Area.

DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The data will be kept for 8 days as established by the pertinent Provision of the Data Protection Supervisor Provision of 28/12/2006 [1413635].

DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

All the rights of the data subject are guaranteed in accordance with the provisions of Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22 and 77 of the GDPR:

- right of access to personal data and all information on the processing carried out;
- right to rectification of inaccurate personal data and integration of incomplete personal data;
- right to erasure ('right to be forgotten');
- right to limit the processing of personal data;
- right to data portability;
- right to object to the processing of personal data;
- right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing;
- right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority in case a violation is thought to have been carried out.
