

PRIVACY POLICY "VIDEO SURVEILLANCE"

PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF EU REGULATION NO. 679/2016 AND TO THE PROVISION OF THE DATA PROTECTION AUTHORITY (APRIL 8, 2010)

DATA CONTROLLER AND CONTACTS

PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS

The purpose of the processing is:

- A. the "protection of assets", whose legal basis is a legitimate interest pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, letter f) of EU Regulation 679/2016;
- B. the "control of the exercise", whose legal basis is the performance of a task of public interest or related to the exercise of public authority, which is vested in the holder (safety and security), pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, letter e) of EU Regulation 679/2016.

CATEGORIES OF DATA PROCESSED

Data processed are images and video footage.

DATA DISCLOSURE

Personal data are processed by personnel authorized pursuant to Article 29 of the GDPR and Article 2-quaterdecies of the Italian Data Protection Code and may be disclosed to Law Enforcement Authorities and the Judicial Authority. Such data will be made available to companies supplying goods and/or services related to the processing.

METHODS OF PROCESSING

The processing of personal data may also be carried out through automated and computerized procedures, by means of the operations of collection, recording, organization, storage, consultation, processing, alteration, selection, retrieval, comparison, use, interconnection, restriction, disclosure, erasure and destruction of the data. Furthermore, the data are processed solely for the purposes indicated above, in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, accuracy, integrity and confidentiality established by the applicable legislation.

DATA TRANSFER

No transfer of the personal data collected for the purposes set out above to third countries outside the European Economic Area or to international organizations is currently envisaged. Should such transfer become necessary, it will be carried out based on an adequacy decision pursuant to Article 45 of the GDPR and in compliance with the appropriate safeguards provided for under Article 46 of the GDPR.

DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The data will be retained, with reference to the purpose referred to in point A) and B), for a maximum period of seven days.

PROVISION OF DATA

The provision of personal data is mandatory for purpose A) and B). Any refusal to provide such data shall result in the impossibility of accessing certain areas (e.g.: metro concourses) and means of transport (e.g.: buses, trams, metro trains).

DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

All the rights of the data subject are guaranteed in accordance with the provisions of Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22 and 77 of the GDPR:

- right of access to your personal data and all information on the processing carried out;
- right to rectification of inaccurate personal data and integration of incomplete data;
- right to erasure ('right to be forgotten');
- right to limit the processing of your personal data;
- right to data portability;
- right to object to the processing of your personal data;
- right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing;
- right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority in case a violation is thought to have been carried out.

Should the data subject believe that their rights have been infringed, they are entitled to lodge a complaint.
